Many centuries ago, the natural harbor of Avila Beach area was used by the Spaniards and Portuguese to replenish fresh water and to rest after a rough passage around Point Conception.

In later times, smugglers used the Port for illegal nighttime movement of liquor. Large quantities came ashore in the area now known as Pirate's Cove just south of here and in the Port itself. G-men had a hard time catching the persons involved as it was a community effort and outsiders were not welcome.

In 1954, the citizens of Southern San Luis Obispo County voted to create and fund a Harbor District for the Port of San Luis area. Around this time, the Harbor District built the Port Master's home.

All harbor building was directed through the Harbor Master at this site. When the Harbor Commission offices were built and the Port Master's home was no longer needed, it was transformed into a rustic restaurant named Marcie's.

In January of 1985, we purchased Marcie's and the renovation started.

In June of that year, Fat Cat's was opened for business.

The Fat Cat's name came from a big yellow and black cat that adopted the restaurant during construction and stayed on for some time after.
